SEASON OF PENTECOST

May 28 — August 26, 2023 (Pulpit Attire is Red)



THE COLOR OF FIRE REPRESENTS THE HOLY SPIRIT. Pentecost, the fiftieth day after Easter, comes from the Greek word for fiftieth, *pentekoste*. Greek-speaking Jews called the Jewish Feast of Weeks the Day of Pentecost. Acts 2 tells how the anxious and fearful disciples, who had gathered on the Day of Pentecost, were filled with the Holy Spirit and thereafter preached boldly the gospel of Jesus Christ. This is the day on which the church received the Holy Spirit.



<u>Theme For This Quarter:</u> "God's People Worship"

This quarter has three units with a theological emphasis on worship. How does Christian worship today mirror both the pious and impious practices of the ancient world? HOW TO ACCEPT JESUS CHRIST INTO YOUR HEART

Perhaps while reading the announcements you realized you have never made a Christian commitment. Don't delay that decision! We encourage you to embrace God's love today and receive the salvation that only Jesus Christ gives. Here are five simple steps you can take to find assurance of salvation.

- 1. **Recognize your need.** The Bible tell us that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) All of us are sinners, and we must admit our need for a Savior.
- Repent of your sins. Our sins create a wall that separates us from God. By confessing our sins and turning from them, you will find forgiveness. The Bible promises: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).
- 3. Believe in Jesus. God sent His only Son to die so that He could pay for all our sins. Put your faith in Him and believe in His power to save you. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
- 4. **Receive His salvation.** God has given us a great gift in His Son, but we must receive His gift. Thank Him for loving and forgiving you, and ask Him to live in your heart. His promise to us is clear: "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).
- 5. **Confess your faith.** The Bible assures us: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9). You have been born again and are now part of God's family. Tell some one else what Jesus has done in your life!

Both the Democratic and Republican Primary Election will be on June 20, 2023. You will only be able to vote in one political party election. Depending on your voting district, you will be voting for either Virginia House of Delegate, Virginia Senate, or Board of Supervisors candidates. The primary election aims to determine the candidates on the ballot in the November General Election. You are encouraged to review your sample ballot via your locality's Voter Registration website or contact your locality's Voter Registration Office to inquire as to who the candidates are on your particular ballot. Also, please note that the incumbent for the position may not have anyone challenging them, so, therefore, your voting district may not have a ballot for the political party of your choice for this primary election.

Listed below are the dates to remember:

First day of in-person early voting at your local registrar's office:	Friday, May 5, 2023
Deadline to register to vote, or update an existing registration:	May 30, 2023
Deadline to apply for a ballot to be mailed to You (Your request must be received by your Local Voter Registration Office by 5:00 pm:	June 9, 2023
Voter Registration offices Saturdays opened for early voting:	June 10, 2023, and June 17, 2023
The last day to vote early is June 17, 2023. After this da	ate, you will have to go to your polling
