THE COLOR OF FIRE REPRESENTS THE HOLY SPIRIT.

Pentecost, the fiftieth day after Easter, comes from the Greek word for fiftieth, *pentekoste*. Greek-speaking Jews called the Jewish Feast of Weeks the Day of Pentecost. Acts 2 tells how the anxious and fearful disciples, who had gathered on the Day of Pentecost, were filled with the Holy Spirit and thereafter preached boldly the gospel of Jesus Christ. This is the day on which the church received the Holy Spirit.



Theme For This Quarter: "WISDOM"

People experience God's wisdom in both the Hebrew Scriptures and the New Testament. During this quarter, we explore the many facets of wisdom as recorded in the book of Proverbs, in the Gospels, and in the letter written by James.

UNIT 3 — FAITH AND WISDOM IN JAMES

This unit offers a five-lesson study of wisdom as seen in the letter of James. These lessons explore the interaction of faith and wisdom, including practical advice regarding faith in action and taming the tongue. The study ends by contrasting two kinds of wisdom.

Perhaps while reading the announcements you realized you have never made a Christian commitment. Don't delay that decision! We encourage you to embrace God's love today and receive the salvation that only Jesus Christ gives. Here are five simple steps you can take to find assurance of salvation.

- Recognize your need. The Bible tell us that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) All of us are sinners, and we must admit our need for a Savior.
- Repent of your sins. Our sins create a wall that separates us from God. By confessing our sins and turning from them, you will find forgiveness. The Bible promises: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).
- 3. **Believe in Jesus.** God sent His only Son to die so that He could pay for all our sins. Put your faith in Him and believe in His power to save you. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
- 4. Receive His salvation. God has given us a great gift in His Son, but we must receive His gift. Thank Him for loving and forgiving you, and ask Him to live in your heart. His promise to us is clear: "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).
- 5. Confess your faith. The Bible assures us: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9). You have been born again and are now part of God's family. Tell some one else what Jesus has done in your life!

The General Election is steadfastly approaching. Viewing your registration status and voter information has gotten easier with the Virginia Department of Elections' citizen portal. You may review your information at www.elections.virginia.gov. You will need to click on "Registration". Then click on "View your info". You may also contact your locality's Voter Registration Office to check on your voting status.

TIDBIT #2

UPDATING YOUR NAME OR ADDRESS

To remain a qualified registered voter, the law requires you to notify your local registration office of any change in your name or address. This must be done before the registration books close for the next election. The deadline to register to vote, or update an existing registration for the upcoming election is Tuesday, October 13, 2020, 5:00 PM. If you want to make a change to your address, name or other information, you may do so by:

Using the online registration portal (see website information above)

By **completing** the Virginia Voter Registration Application

Or

Sending a letter to your General Registrar

Letters should be addressed to the Voter Registration Office for the **City** or **County** in which you live. Letters should include the following information:

- 1. Name
- Enough information to identify you such as the Social Security Number
- 3. Current address
- 4. Previous address



What is Measles?

Over the last 7 years, the United States has seen an increase in cases of Measles. Measles is a very contagious disease that spreads when an infected person coughs or sneezes.

Did you know

- Measles can live for up to 2 hours in the atmosphere. Hence, if you breathe contaminated air or touch an infected surface then touch your eyes, nose, or mouth then you can become infected
- Two doses of the MMR are 97% effective against measles and 88% effective against Mumps

Signs/Symptoms

- Hight Fever followed by cough, runny nose, and red eyes
- 2-3 days later tiny white spots may be seen in the inside of the mouth, these are called Koplik spots
- 3-5 days later, a tiny red, rash follows which begins at the head and spreads to the rest of the body

Prevention

- The CDC recommends 2 doses of the MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) vaccine. The first dose is between ages 12 15 months and second dose at 4-6 years of age
- Avoid sick contacts
- Practice good hand hygiene
