The General Election is steadfastly approaching. To start getting voters prepared for the election in November 2020, the Civic Ministry would be providing different tidbits of information you will need regarding voting. Voters who reside outside of Henrico County are strongly encouraged to check with their respective counties website for their information. Let's start early getting prepared for November! Remember every vote counts!

TIDBIT #1

Am I Eligible to Vote in Henrico?

- You must be a resident of Henrico County and registered to vote.
- To be registered, you must be at least 18 years old and a US citizen. If you ever been convicted of a felony or have had your civil rights removed for mental incapacity, you must have had your civil rights restored and all disabilities removed.
- The deadline to register is 29 days before the election.
- Once your name is added to the voter list, you will receive a voter registration card which tells you where to vote.
- If you do not complete the voter registration application or if you are not qualified to be a registered voter, you will receive a denial letter.
- If you do not receive a voter registration card or a denial letter, call the Voter Registration and Elections Office and ask about the status of your application.

Once registered, voters are not required to re-register prior to each election, but voters are required to notify the Voter Registration and Elections Office of any change in name or address with a signed statement or new voter registration application.

What is Measles?

Over the last 7 years, the United States has seen an increase in cases of Measles. Measles is a very contagious disease that spreads when an infected person coughs or sneezes.

Did you know

- Measles can live for up to 2 hours in the atmosphere. Hence, if you breathe contaminated air or touch an infected surface then touch your eyes, nose, or mouth then you can become infected
- Two doses of the MMR are 97% effective against measles and 88% effective against Mumps

Signs/Symptoms

- Hight Fever followed by cough, runny nose, and red eyes
- 2-3 days later tiny white spots may be seen in the inside of the mouth, these are called Koplik spots
- 3-5 days later, a tiny red, rash follows which begins at the head and spreads to the rest of the body

Prevention

- The CDC recommends 2 doses of the MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) vaccine. The first dose is between ages 12 – 15 months and second dose at 4-6 years of age
- Avoid sick contacts
- Practice good hand hygiene
