<u>Theme For This Quarter:</u> "JUSTICE, LAW, HISTORY"

The study this quarter focuses on justice as presented in a variety of Old Testament Scriptures. Justice originates in the nature of God and is given to God's people as a gift under the Law. The history of God's covenant people shows that kings who exercised God's justice according to God's Law were considered good kings.

UNII 3* "JUSTICE and ADVERSITY"

This unit has five lessons that deals with situations in which justice seems absent. In 2 Samuels, Nathan condemns David for his acts of injustice toward Uriah the Hittite, Bathsheba's husband. In Ezra, after years of exile in Babylon, Ezra returns to Jerusalem and determines to restore respect for God's Law. Lesson 3 tells the story of Job's faithfulness to God after several tragic events in his life. The Scriptures in Job question the presence of God's justice when Job has suffered greatly.

HOW TO ACCEPT JESUS CHRIST INTO YOUR HEART

Perhaps while reading the announcements you realized you have never made a Christian commitment. Don't delay that decision! We encourage you to embrace God's love today and receive the salvation that only Jesus Christ gives. Here are five simple steps you can take to find assurance of salvation.

- 1. **Recognize your need.** The Bible tell us that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) All of us are sinners, and we must admit our need for a Savior.
- Repent of your sins. Our sins create a wall that separates us from God. By confessing our sins and turning from them, you will find forgiveness. The Bible promises: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).
- 3. **Believe in Jesus.** God sent His only Son to die so that He could pay for all our sins. Put your faith in Him and believe in His power to save you. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
- 4. **Receive His salvation.** God has given us a great gift in His Son, but we must receive His gift. Thank Him for loving and forgiving you, and ask Him to live in your heart. His promise to us is clear: "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).
- 5. **Confess your faith.** The Bible assures us: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9). You have been born again and are now part of God's family. Tell some one else what Jesus has done in your life!

Heavenly Father, I now understand my need to have my sins forgiven. I also realize that only Jesus — because of His sacrifice on the cross — can forgive my sin. I put my faith and trust in Jesus today. Please forgive me and become the Lord of my life.



They call me that cause' I was a Virginia slave who escaped to freedom by mailing myself in a dry goods container from Richmond to Philadelphia. I was born into slavery in 1815 in Louisa County, Virginia and was sent to Richmond in 1830 to work in a tobacco factory. I saved up my wages to pay the master of my wife Nancy and our three kids' for time she spent caring for them. But my wife and kids was sold anyhow to a slave trader and sent to North Carolina. I was heartbroken and powerless to stop this awful thing from happening. I was so upset that I decided I would mail myself to freedom!

My journey lasted for about 27 hours. My box traveled by way of wagon, then railroad, steamboat, wagon again, railroad, ferry, railroad, and finally delivery wagon. Whoa! Can you image that kinda trip? How many times the workers placed my box upside-down tossed it to and fro. I tell you...it was by the grace o' God I was able to stay still enough to avoid them finding' me.

When my box finally reached Philadelphia and some abolitionist let me out my first words was "How do you do, gentlemen?" And I sang a psalm from the Bible for my moment of freedom.
