The Easter Season, also known as the Great fifty Days, begins at sunset on Easter Eve and continues through the Day of Pentecost. At this season we celebrate with joy, Christ's resurrection and ascension, and the giving of the Holy Spirit on the first Easter (John 20: 22-23) and on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2).



### Theme For This Quarter: "Beyond the Present Time"

The study this quarter focuses on the theological theme of hope in both the Old and New Testament. In addition, students will consider the resurrection hope of believers, who wait for Christ's return and focus on the hope that Jesus inspires for those who are suffering.

#### UNIT 3 "A Call to Holy Living"

This is a four-lesson study of 1 and 2 Peter. These studies focus on the hope that Jesus inspires for those who are suffering — Jesus' life, death, and resurrection for our "new birth into a living hope" (1 Peter 1:3).

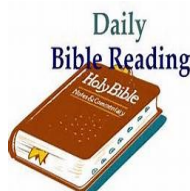

### HOW TO ACCEPT JESUS CHRIST INTO YOUR HEART

Perhaps while reading the announcements you realized you have never made a Christian commitment. Don't delay that decision! We encourage you to embrace God's love today and receive the salvation that only Jesus Christ gives. Here are five simple steps you can take to find assurance of salvation.

1. **Recognize your need.** The Bible tell us that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) All of us are sinners, and we must admit our need for a Savior.
2. **Repent of your sins.** Our sins create a wall that separates us from God. By confessing our sins and turning from them, you will find forgiveness. The Bible promises: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).
3. **Believe in Jesus.** God sent His only Son to die so that He could pay for all our sins. Put your faith in Him and believe in His power to save you. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
4. **Receive His salvation.** God has given us a great gift in His Son, but we must receive His gift. Thank Him for loving and forgiving you, and ask Him to live in your heart. His promise to us is clear: "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).
5. **Confess your faith.** The Bible assures us: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9). You have been born again and are now part of God's family. Tell some one else what Jesus has done in your life!

Heavenly Father, I now understand my need to have my sins forgiven. I also realize that only Jesus — because of His sacrifice on the cross — can forgive my sin. I put my faith and trust in Jesus today. Please forgive me and become the Lord of my life.

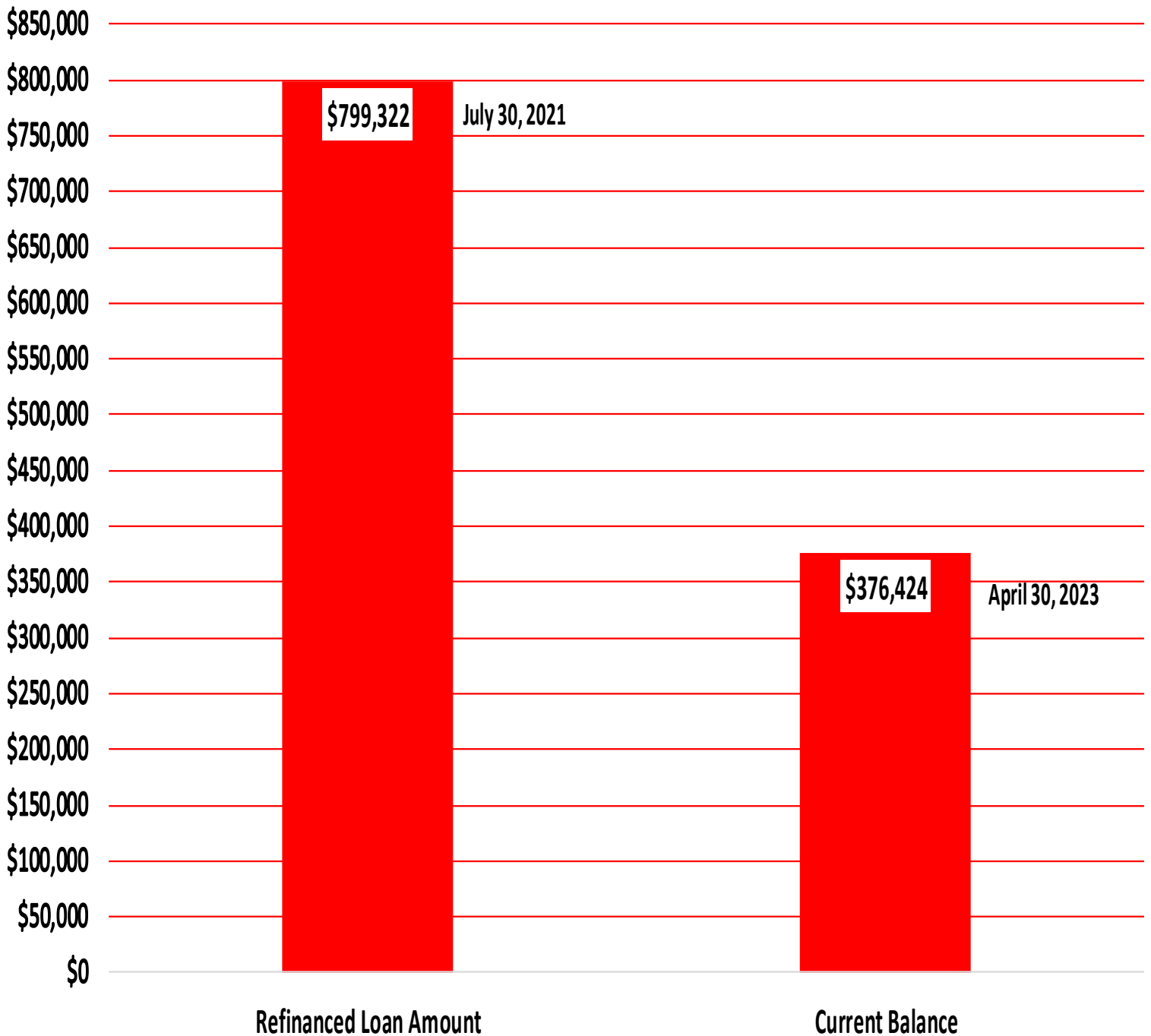

## JUNE 20, 2023

Both the Democratic and Republican Primary Election will be on June 20, 2023. You will only be able to vote in one political party election. Depending on your voting district, you will be voting for either Virginia House of Delegate, Virginia Senate, or Board of Supervisors candidates. The primary election aims to determine the candidates on the ballot in the November General Election. You are encouraged to review your sample ballot via your locality's Voter Registration website or contact your locality's Voter Registration Office to inquire as to who the candidates are on your particular ballot. Also, please note that the incumbent for the position may not have anyone challenging them, so, therefore, your voting district may not have a ballot for the political party of your choice for this primary election.

Listed below are the dates to remember:

First day of in-person early voting at your local registrar's office:

Friday, May 5, 2023

Deadline to register to vote, or update an existing registration:

May 30, 2023

Deadline to apply for a ballot to be mailed to You (Your request must be received by your Local Voter Registration Office by 5:00 pm:

June 9, 2023

Voter Registration offices Saturdays opened for early voting:

June 10, 2023, and June 17, 2023




The last day to vote early is June 17, 2023. After this date, you will have to go to your polling location on Election Day.
