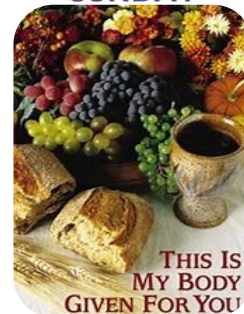

The Pulpit Attire is Green

We are in the season of **KINGDOMTIDE**, the color of **KINGDOMTIDE** is **GREEN**. The color **GREEN** symbolizes growth. **KINGDOMTIDE** runs from August 26th until Advent. **KINGDOMTIDE** is the newest of the seasons, dating no farther back than the late 1930's. **KINGDOMTIDE** gives place for due attention to the eternal presence of Christ and His Kingship — with the parallel emphasis upon our stewardship. Its emphasis on the kingship of Christ and His kingdom, challenges us in our daily lives and in every area of our existence.



Theme For This Quarter:

"LOVE FOR ONE ANOTHER"

God commands us to love one another as God loves us. This quarter begins with a widely known story about Joseph, which deals with love within Jacob's family. These lessons elaborate on themes of love for one another in the epistles of Paul and James and the expressions of love in the early formations of the church in Acts.

UNIT 3 — GODLY LOVE AMONG BELIEVERS

This unit contains five lessons. John elaborates on how believers love by serving and portray Jesus' explanation of the intertwining love of God for Jesus and for those who abide in Christ. First John clarifies the abiding love of God through the Holy Spirit, which makes it possible for us to love one another. Acts reveals the expression of the love of God in the formation of the early Christian community by the workings of the Holy Spirit. James tells of the love of neighbor as the fulfillment of the law of God.

HOW TO ACCEPT JESUS CHRIST INTO YOUR HEART

Perhaps while reading the announcements you realized you have never made a Christian commitment. Don't delay that decision! We encourage you to embrace God's love today and receive the salvation that only Jesus Christ gives. Here are five simple steps you can take to find assurance of salvation.

1. **Recognize your need.** The Bible tells us that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) All of us are sinners, and we must admit our need for a Savior.
2. **Repent of your sins.** Our sins create a wall that separates us from God. By confessing our sins and turning from them, you will find forgiveness. The Bible promises: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).
3. **Believe in Jesus.** God sent His only Son to die so that He could pay for all our sins. Put your faith in Him and believe in His power to save you. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
4. **Receive His salvation.** God has given us a great gift in His Son, but we must receive His gift. Thank Him for loving and forgiving you, and ask Him to live in your heart. His promise to us is clear: "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).
5. **Confess your faith.** The Bible assures us: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9). You have been born again and are now part of God's family. Tell someone else what Jesus has done in your life!

Heavenly Father, I now understand my need to have my sins forgiven. I also realize that only Jesus — because of His sacrifice on the cross — can forgive my sin. I put my faith and trust in Jesus today. Please forgive me and become the Lord of my life.

What is No-Shave November?

It is a concept in which men and women forgo shaving to evoke conversation and raise awareness about cancer.

Did you know

The top five cancers that plague African-Americans are:

- ◇ Prostate Cancer
- ◇ Breast Cancer
- ◇ Lung Cancer
- ◇ Colon Cancer
- ◇ Uterine Cancer

How do I participate in No-Shave November?

Forgo shaving your head, legs, or cutting beards/hair for 30 days and donate the money typically used for grooming to your favorite cancer organization.

Cancer Prevention

- ◇ Research cancers that are prominent in their family and have a discussion with your primary care provider regarding your risks of developing those cancers.
- ◇ Obesity, lack of exercise, red meat, alcohol, or smoking can increase your risk of having certain cancers and thus, eliminating these or reducing your intake of certain foods, alcohol, along with stop smoking can decrease your risks. Thirty minutes of moderate intensity exercise will help with weight loss and decrease your risk of cancer as well.
- ◇ Make sure you are up to date on all preventive screenings to include:
 - ⇒ PSA – prostate-specific antigen
 - ⇒ Mammogram
 - ⇒ Pap smear
 - ⇒ Colonoscopy
 - ⇒ Low-dose Cat Scan of the chest if you are a smoker or have a history of smoking
