2022 GENERAL ELECTION

The General Election is steadfastly approaching. We will be voting for House of Representatives.

Henrico County residents will also have four Bond Referendum questions on the ballot. Henrico County voters will consider whether to fund more than \$511 million in county capital projects as part of this General Election. The four questions will pertain to (1) Schools; (2) Recreation and Parks; (3) Fire Station and Public Safety Facilities; and, (4) Storm Water Drainage. Some localities may have some local offices on the ballot.

It is the desire of the Civic Ministry to provide you with the necessary information you will need regarding voting.

The deadline to register to vote, or update an existing registration for this Election is Monday, October 17, 2022.

ABSENTEE VOTING

First day of in-person absentee voting at local voter registration office begins on Friday, **September 23, 2022**. Voter registration offices are opened Monday through Friday for absentee in-person voting. Henrico County hours are **8:00 AM to 4:30 PM**.

Two Saturdays have also been designated for early in-person voting – October 29, 2022 and November 5, 2022.

Last day to vote absentee at your localities voter registration office – Saturday, November 5. 2022. After November 5, 2022, you will have to go to your polling location on Election Day.

VOTE BY MAIL

Deadline to submit an application for a ballot to be mailed to you – **Friday October 28, 2022**. Request must be received by voter registration office by 5:00 PM. This is the last day that an application to vote by mail will be accepted.

Keep in mind when voting by mail you must allow time for the ballot to be mailed to you and for you to return the ballot by mail. Voters who will be voting by mail are strongly encouraged to request and submit your application as soon as possible.

Please be aware that all voter registration offices have drop off boxes for voters who desire to return their **completed ballots** in person as oppose to mailing via the post office.


