HOW TO ACCEPT JESUS CHRIST INTO YOUR HEART

Perhaps while reading the announcements you realized you have never made a Christian commitment. Don't delay that decision! We encourage you to embrace God's love today and receive the salvation that only Jesus Christ gives. Here are five simple steps you can take to find assurance of salvation

- Recognize your need. The Bible tell us that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) All of us are sinners, and we must admit our need for a Savior.
- Repent of your sins. Our sins create a wall that separates us from God. By confessing our sins and turning from them, you will find forgiveness. The Bible promises: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).
- Believe in Jesus. God sent His only Son to die so that He could pay for all our sins. Put your faith in Him and believe in His power to save you. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
- 4. Receive His salvation. God has given us a great gift in His Son, but we must receive His gift. Thank Him for loving and forgiving you, and ask Him to live in your heart. His promise to us is clear: "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).
- 5. Confess your faith. The Bible assures us: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9). You have been born again and are now part of God's family. Tell some one else what Jesus has done in your life!

SMOKING Nicotine Dependence

What is Nicotine Dependence?

Nicotine is an addictive substance found in tobacco products such as cigarettes, e-cigarette cartridges, and chewing tobacco. Nicotine increases the release of brain chemicals in particular dopamine. Dopamine activates the pleasure center of the brain causing improvements in mood and the desire to have more nicotine, which eventually leads to nicotine dependence (aka addiction).

Risk factors

Using tobacco products, such as cigarettes, has harmful effects on the body to include:

- Lung diseases such as emphysema, chronic bronchitis, increased risk of lung infections such as flu, pneumonia, and coronavirus
- Diseases of the vessels to include stroke, heart attack, decreased blood flow in the legs which may lead to amputation
- Increased risk for certain cancers such as lung, cervical, bladder, pancreatic, kidney, throat, and oral cancers.

Treatment

Most people who use nicotine will make several unsuccessful attempts to stop on their own. However, there are multiple resources to help you stop smoking. The first step is to start a conversation with your primary care provider about the multiple options to help you stop smoking. Your provider may recommend over the counter medications such as (nicotine gum or patches) as well as prescribed medications. In addition, your provider may recommend counseling to help you identify what triggers you to smoke. With a counselor, you may come up with an alternate list of things you can do when you have nicotine cravings or experience nicotine withdrawal symptoms. Symptoms of nicotine withdrawal include strong cravings, anxiety, irritability, restlessness, increased hunger, insomnia, constipation, or diarrhea.

Do know that quitting for most people is not easy and it may take several attempts before you are successful. However, do know there are resources available to support you in your journey such as 1-800- QUIT-NOW.

The General Election is steadfastly approaching. We will be voting for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General and House of Delegates. Some localities may have some local offices on the ballot.

It is the desire of the Civic Ministry to provide you with the necessary information you will need regarding voting.

The deadline to register to vote, or update an existing registration for this Election is Tuesday, October 12, 2021.

EARLY VOTING

First day of in-person early voting at local voter registration office begins on Friday, September 17, 2021.

Voter registration offices are opened Monday through Friday for early in-person voting. Henrico County hours are 8:00am to 4:30pm.

Two Saturdays have also been designated for early in-person voting – October 23, 2021 and October 30, 2021.

Last day to vote early at local voter registration office – Saturday, October 30, 2021. After October 30, 2021, you will have to go to your polling location on Election Day.

VOTE BY MAIL

Deadline to submit an application for a ballot to be mailed to you – Friday October 22, 2021. Request must be received by voter registration office by 5:00pm. This is the last day that an application to vote by mail will be accepted.

Keep in mind when voting by mail you must allow time for the ballot to be mailed to you and for you to return the ballot by mail.

Voters who will be voting by mail are strongly encouraged to request and submit your application as soon as possible.

Please be aware that all voter registration offices have drop off boxes for voters who desire to return their **completed ballots** in person as oppose to mailing via the post office.

This is a free service to the residence of Henrico County.


