

Redistricting of Virginia Voting Districts

In case you are not aware, the law was passed that enabled Virginia to make changes to the Voting Districts. You should be receiving letters in the near future from your local Voter's Registration Office regarding the changes. You are strongly encouraged to pay attention to the letters as they will contain significant information.
