THE COLOR OF FIRE REPRESENTS THE HOLY SPIRIT.

Pentecost, the fiftieth day after Easter, comes from the Greek word for fiftieth, *pentekoste*. Greek-speaking Jews called the Jewish Feast of Weeks the Day of Pentecost. Acts 2 tells how the anxious and fearful disciples, who had gathered on the Day of Pentecost, were filled with the Holy Spirit and thereafter preached boldly the gospel of Jesus Christ. This is the day on which the church received the Holy Spirit.



Theme For This Quarter: "WISDOM"

People experience God's wisdom in both the Hebrew Scriptures and the New Testament. During this quarter, we explore the many facets of wisdom as recorded in the book of Proverbs, in the Gospels, and in the letter written by James.

UNIT 1 — WISDOM IN PROVERBS

This unit explores the nature of God's wisdom as found in the book of Proverbs. These lessons describe how wisdom calls to us, the value of wisdom and the gifts she offers, and finally the metaphor of the feast of wisdom.

HOW TO ACCEPT JESUS CHRIST INTO YOUR HEART

Perhaps while reading the announcements you realized you have never made a Christian commitment. Don't delay that decision! We encourage you to embrace God's love today and receive the salvation that only Jesus Christ gives. Here are five simple steps you can take to find assurance of salvation.

1. **Recognize your need.** The Bible tell us that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) All of us are sinners, and we must admit our need for a Savior.
2. **Repent of your sins.** Our sins create a wall that separates us from God. By confessing our sins and turning from them, you will find forgiveness. The Bible promises: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).
3. **Believe in Jesus.** God sent His only Son to die so that He could pay for all our sins. Put your faith in Him and believe in His power to save you. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16).
4. **Receive His salvation.** God has given us a great gift in His Son, but we must receive His gift. Thank Him for loving and forgiving you, and ask Him to live in your heart. His promise to us is clear: "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).
5. **Confess your faith.** The Bible assures us: "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9). You have been born again and are now part of God's family. Tell some one else what Jesus has done in your life!

Heavenly Father, I now understand my need to have my sins forgiven. I also realize that only Jesus — because of His sacrifice on the cross — can forgive my sin. I put my faith and trust in Jesus today. Please forgive me and become the Lord of my life.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee Voting for the June Primary Election has begun. Absentee Voting is designed for voters who cannot make it out to their respective polling place on Election Day. Absentee voting is held at your locality's Voter Registration Office. The actual primary will be on June 23rd.

For voters who desire to vote by mail, you may go to www.elections.virginia.gov and complete the application on the website. You may also contact your county's Voter Registration Office to request the application. Henrico County office number is 804-501-4347. The deadline to submit the application for the ballot to be mailed to you is June 16, 2020. The last day to vote absentee in person at the Voter Registration Office is Saturday, June, 20, 2020. After June 20, 2020, you will need to go vote at your designated polling location.

There are two ballots for the Primary Election (**Democratic and Republican**). You may only cast one ballot.

Primary Elections determine who will be on the ballot in the November (General Election). Listed below is a synopsis of the two ballots. **The House of Representative information provided is for Henrico County voters.** The Republican Ballot is for the United States Senate which is for the entire state of Virginia.

Democratic Ballot: House of Representative (4th Congressional District). The current Representative for the 4th District is Senator Donald McEachin. There is one other Democratic candidate opposing Senator McEachin.

For information, House of Representative Abigail Spanberger (Democrat) (7th District) is unopposed.

Republican Ballot – United States Senate (State-Wide Election) Senator Mark R. Warner (Democrat), our current senator, is unopposed. You will only be voting in the Primary Election for the Republican candidate to run against Senator Warner in November.
