ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee Voting for the June Primary Election has begun. Absentee Voting is designed for voters who cannot make it out to their respective polling place on Election Day. Absentee voting is held at your locality's Voter Registration Office. The actual primary will be on June 23rd.

For voters who desire to vote by mail, you may go to <u>www.elections.virginia.gov</u> and complete the application on the website. You may also contact your county's Voter Registration Office to request the application. Henrico County office number is 804-501-4347. The deadline to submit the application for the ballot to be mailed to you is June 16, 2020. The last day to vote absentee in person at the Voter Registration Office is Saturday, June, 20, 2020. After June 20, 2020, you will need to go vote at your designated polling location.

There are two ballots for the Primary Election (**Democratic and Republican**). You may only cast one ballot.

Primary Elections determine who will be on the ballot in the November (General Election). Listed below is a synopsis of the two ballots. The House of Representative information provided is for Henrico County voters. The Republican Ballot is for the United States Senate which is for the entire state of Virginia.

Democratic Ballot: House of Representative (4th Congressional District). The current Representative for the 4th District is Senator Donald McEachin. There is one other Democratic candidate opposing Senator McEachin.

For information, House of Representative Abigail Spanberger (Democrat) (7th District) is unopposed.

Republican Ballot – United States Senate (State-Wide Election) Senator Mark R. Warner (Democrat), our current senator, is unopposed. You will only be voting in the Primary Election for the Republican candidate to run against Senator Warner in November.
