Theme For This Quarter: "JUSTICE" "JUSTICE" This study this quarter focuses on justice as presented in Scriptures from the prophets and in the reading for Easter Sunday, which is taken from First Corinthians. The prophets communicated God's will to the people. They called for repentance and justice. INEW UNIT 1 — GOD REQUIRES JUSTICE This is a five-lesson study from four of the minor prophets. The prophets issue God's call for justice in the conduct of human affairs. Amos, Habak- kuk, Micah, and Malachi convey that the laws of God require justice for the poor and the oppressed. The last two lesson from Micah and Malachi are a study of the responsibilities of leaders for practicing justice. NEXT WEEK'S LESSON: March 1, 2020 "Called to Accountability" Amos 5:18-24 Often, people ignore or disregard the plight of the disenfranchised. How will the cause of these disadvantaged be addressed? The bible tell us that all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) All of us are sinners, and we must admit our need for a Sav- ior. Repent of your sins. Our sins create a wall that sepa- rates us from God. By confessing our sins and turning from them, you will find forgiveness. The Bible promises "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unright- eousness" (1 John 1:9). Believe in Jesus. God sent His only Son to die so that He could pay for all our sins. Put your faith in Him and believe in His power to save you. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16). Receive His salvation. God has given us a great gift in His Son, but we must receive His gift. Thank Him for loving and forgiving you, and ask Him to live in your heart. His promise to us is clear: "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12). Confess your faith. The Bible assures us: "If you con- fess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in you heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Rom. 10:9). You have been born again and are now part of God's family. Tell some one else what Jesu has done in your life! Heavenly Father, I now understand my need to have my sins forgiven. 
